Key vocabulary:

• **Collage** - is an art technique that mixes and uses different materials to make a picture.



• **Texture** - the way a material feels.

• **PVA glue** - a liquid white glue that turns clear when dry, perfect for using with paper, fabric, wood, etc.




• **Landscape** - everything you can see when you look across an area of land, including hills, rivers, trees and plants.



What will we be making?

In a few weeks we will be making a seaside collage using different materials to show different textures.



What is a collage?



A collage is a picture that is made up from different materials. It can be made from any material such as paper, leaves, cotton wool, toilet roll, etc.

The materials are then cut up to the size and shape you want it to be and it is stuck onto paper using a glue stick or **PVA glue**.

Let's have a look at a collage:

Leaves have been used to create the leaves of the tree.

Paint has been used to create the sky, grass and soil.



Bark and sticks have been used to create the trunk of the tree.



Collage Making



Be careful when making your collage as you do not want to go over the lines!
Therefore use smaller pieces of material to make your work look neater!



Do not use large pieces of material.



Smaller uneven pieces look much more effective.
