

## 7. Gaps in learning: Piet Mondrian Art

Read the paragraph and answer the questions.

Tone is the lightness or darkness of a colour. When you change the tone of a colour, you can describe it as being warm or cool, bright or dull, light or dark, and pure or "dirty." Warmer colours are colours that are usually bright and remind you of summer. Cool colours include green, blue and violet, these are colours that remind you of a calm lake. Bright colours are cheerful colours that you can see very easily and dull colours are very light colours that look like it has been faded or washed. Pure colours are made up of one colour and dirty colours are colours that are mixed with dark colours such as black and brown to make it look muddy or shaded.

a. What is a bright colour?

A bright colour is a colour that can be seen easily

b. What is a dull colour?

A dull colour is a colour that is very light or faded.

c. What do cool colours remind you of?

Cool colours remind you of a calm lake.

d. Why are some colours described as dirty?

Some colours are described as dirty because they are mixed with dark colours to make them look muddy or shaded.
