

## L.O: To create a seaside collage.

- I understand what a collage is.
- I can use materials I collected to make my seaside collage.

### Key vocabulary:

**Collage** - is an art technique that mixes and uses different materials to create a picture.

**Texture** - the way something feels.



**Rubbing technique** - This is when you gently rub a crayon or colouring pencil over a surface or **texture** to create a **print**.

Each collage has tried to use colours that are similar to colours seen at the seaside - a light blue sky, a darker blue for the sky and yellow for the sand.
