Nursery Activities to do at home with your child

1. You can access Twinkl which is a website offering free resources for parents during school closures.

Click on the EYFS tab which will lead you to some resources you can use at home.

- 2. Cut up some paper into 5 pieces and encourage the children to copy a number from 1 to 5 on each piece. Encourage them to tell you the number then put them in the correct order.
- 3. Repeat the above activity instead use 10 pieces of paper and encourage them to copy numbers 1-
- 4. Continue reading books with them at home and ask them questions like: 'what is happening in this story? Who is in this story? Why does he feel sad? What do you think might happen next?'
- 5. Encourage children to draw a picture about a story you have shared with them. Ask them to talk to you about the marks they have made?
- 6. Practise copying each letter in your child's name using the name card given to you at school.
- 7. Play interactively with toys your child is interested in and encourage them to make up their own story. For example: they build a castle. You can start the story by saying once upon a time, there lived a prince and princess at this big castle..... Encourage them to complete. It may be short and that's ok.
- 8. Make play dough using the recipe that was handed by the class teacher at the beginning of the year.
- 9. Encourage children to mould numbers or letters in their name.
- 10. Encourage your child to build a model using empty cereal boxes. Give them cellotape and other cartons for their model.

Other activities can involve:

- Painting
- Puzzles
- Board games
- Memory games
- Hand painting
- Baking
- Cooking
