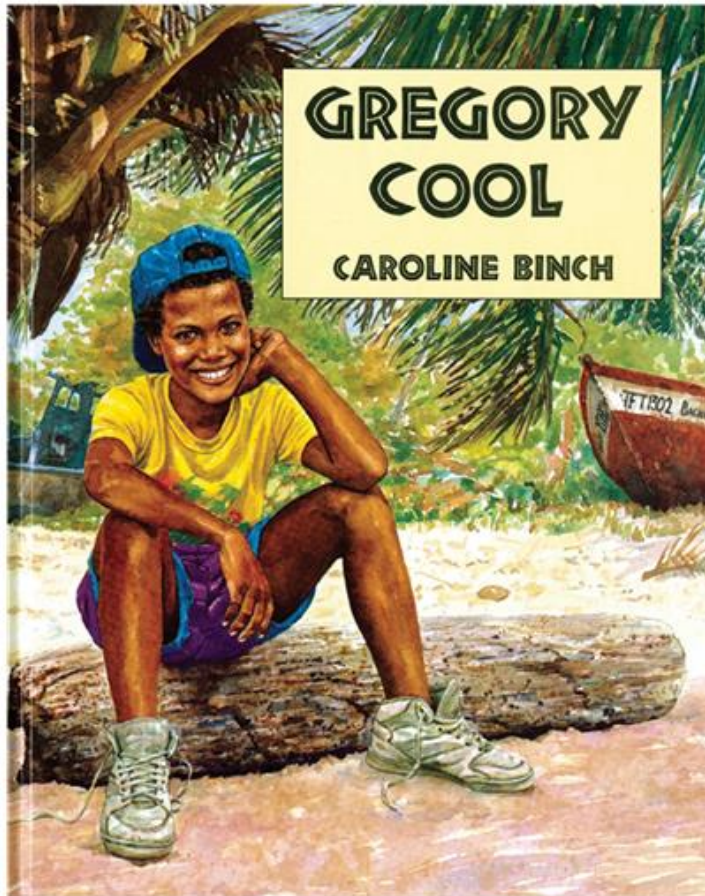

Words: Tired but happy.

Phrases: By the river or near the lake.

Clauses: The lion roared and the mouse ran.

What conjunction completes this sentence?




I wanted to feel the crisp, golden sand so I took off my sandals and strolled along the beach.

What conjunction completes this sentence?

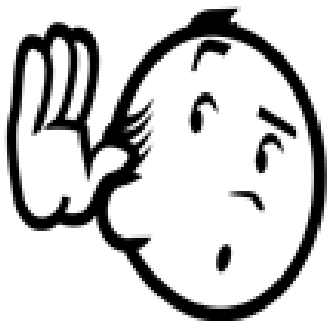


The wind was blowing and it felt
