TASK: Use these questions to help you plan your letter:

1. In the first paragraph how will you introduce yourself? How will you share your reason for writing?

I am going to introduce myself by saying 'Hi Mum and Dad!' I will explain to them that I am writing to them because I miss them but also because I am having such a great time in Tobago that I want to share my experiences with them.

2. In the second paragraph how will you describe how you felt when you first arrived in Tobago?

I will tell them that I was scared and worried when I first arrived in Tobago and I will explain the differences in the way that we live at home in England and how I am living now in Tobago.

3. In the third paragraph how will you describe your new family members (Granny, Grandpa and Lennox)?

I will tell them how sweet Granny is and how funny Grandpa is. I will tell my parents about Lennox- how first I thought he was weird but how he is actually really cool and smart.

4. In the fourth paragraph what experience from Tobago will you write about?

I will tell them about my first trip to the beach and how much I enjoyed it.

6. How will you sign off?
