
Stanley has **brown** hair.


L.O: To write a character description.

Today you will be writing sentences to form a character description about Flat Stanley. You will only be focusing on his appearance.

Remember appearance is what the character looks like.

Make sure to include adjectives to describe his **face**, **hair**, **weight**.

Key words you could include	brown	small	short
	flat	skinny	handsome
	kind	green	flexible



Here are two pictures of Flat Stanley to help you. Remember your capital letters and full stops. Capital letters are used at the beginning of a sentence and also for names. Full stops go at the end of the sentence. Also remember your finger spaces between words!

Here is an example to help you get started.

Stanley has brown hair. He has a flat body. He is wearing a green shirt.

Try to challenge yourself by adding conjunctions such as and, or, but.

For example: Stanley has short, brown hair. He is wearing a green and black shirt. His body is flat but nobody knows why.

Friday 5th June 2020

L.O: To edit and improve my work.

Today you will be editing your work
and trying to improve it!

Don't make the same mistakes I made!

Capital letter in the middle of my sentence.

Missing capital letter at the beginning of my sentence.

Stanley has short, Brown hair. he is wearing a green shirt. He has a flat body

No full stop at the end of my sentence.

Now that I have edited my work, I want to improve it by adding interesting words and conjunctions.

Stanley has **short, brown** hair. He is wearing a **green and black striped** t-shirt. Stanley's body is **flat** and **flexible but** nobody knows why.

Challenge:

You can challenge yourself adding the conjunction 'because'

Everybody always stares at Stanley ***because*** he is so flat.

Sentences have capital letters and full stops.	
Text contains adjectives to describe the appearance of the subject.	
A complete description of the physical appearance of the subject is included.	
Subject-specific vocabulary used.	
Multiple aspects are described (appearance, how it works).	
Related sentences are written together.
