Dear Parents,

Following updates to government guidance we will be reviewing our school Risk Assessment in preparation for the new term. As you may have seen from press reports or social media there will no longer be the expectation that bubbles close following a confirmed case. We will update our school Risk Assessment and share this with you at the start of the new academic year.

There are some changes that we would like to make you aware of before the end of term.

In September we will revert to our original times for the school day. At the start of the day classrooms will be open from 8.35 a.m. Children must be in school by **8.50am** (not 9am), the gates will close at 8.50 and children arriving after this time will be marked late. We will continue with the different entrances in the morning-the main gate for reception to year 4 and the small hall entrance for years 5 and 6. The office area will only be accessible from the front of the school for any queries etc.

School finish times will revert to pre-covid times. Reception to year 2 finishing at **3.20**. Years 3-6 at **3.30**. Children will be dismissed from either the classrooms (reception to year 3) or the current areas-year 4 the hall and years 5 & 6 the main playground.

We ask that you ensure children are wearing full school uniform again in September. This includes black shoes (not boots). See below for the full list. We will continue to ask that children wear their PE kits into school on days they have PE. Again we ask that children wear school uniform expectations for PE.

PE kits should be plain. **Earrings must be small studs.**
