The Five Pillars of Islam

These are the five most important duties for Muslims.



The Shahadah

The belief that there is no God but Allah and that Muhammad is his messenger.

There are 99 names of Allah but no images of Allah.



Salah

Praying five times a day.

Muslims pray facing Mecca, a city in Saudi Arabia.



Zakat

Making an annual charitable donation to help the poor.



Sawm

Fasting during the month of Ramadan.



Hajj

Attending the pilgrimage to Makkah once in your lifetime.

Wudu place – area where you clean yourself in preparation for prayer

Prayer halls – men and women pray in separate halls so they are focused on their prayer

Qibla wall – the direction to which Muslims pray. This is to ensure Muslims pray facing Mecca

Shoe rack – shoes are taken off as a sign of respect and to make sure everyone is equal in the mosque

Prayer mat – placed on the ground for cleanliness
