Reading

Children are expected to read for at least 20/30 minutes every day.

- Children will be given one reading book on <u>Friday</u>.
- Reading records must be signed by an adult and brought in **every day.**
- The reading book will have the sounds they have learnt in the week.
- \circ $\;$ New books will not be given if the reading record is not signed.

Example:

11/9/23	Read with mum. Read very well.
Mike's Kite Pg 1–3	Struggled with the word 'blanket' Answered questions about the characters. Retold the story.



Home Learning



- **Spellings** will be given on **Tuesday** and children tested on Monday. Practice **daily** and bring books Monday.
- **Reading books** given on **Friday** and brought in **daily**.
- **Red home learning books** given on Friday and brought in on **Wednesday**.
- Compulsory Maths, English and Phonics in red home learning books.
